

Do you enjoy coffee, doughnuts and conversation? Then you'll love Middle Grounds, held on




Sunday mornings in Fellowship Hall.

Financial and Trustees Update from Pastor Nathan

If you've been around the church during the past week, you may have noticed some work trucks. That's because some exciting updates are happening at the church. The last part of the Trinity building leaking roof and old HVAC units are being replaced. Due to generous estate gifts, memorial funds, and other undesignated gifts, the Trustees and Finance committee chose to go ahead and tackle these projects after news of enacted tariffs were going to raise the cost significantly. We felt it was in the best interest of the church to go ahead and tackle the project. Soon, we shouldn't have any more major leaks in the Trinity Building and all the HVAC systems will be brand new.

On a related note, we continue to do well on our capital campaign. To date, we have received more than \$800,000 of our pledged gifts and have been able to pay down the loan to below \$325,000! Thank you all so much for your continued commitment as we Unleash our Potential!
