Spiritual Direction Offerings

Spiritual Direction is a guided process in which a person/group of people meet with a trained Spiritual Director in order to explore and discern how God is at work in their lives and inviting them to deepen their relationship with God.

Spiritual Direction explores questions such as:

- Am I doing God's will for my life?
- How do I know this decision is the right one for me?
- Why do I currently feel distant from God?
- What does my spiritual journey look like right now? What would I like it to look like?

Individual Direction

Directees meet one-on-one This is not therapy, but rather a set aside time for the directee to explore what has been occuring on their Spiritual journey.

Group Direction

Dedicated time to learn new/deepen personal Spiritual practices, as well as explore how God has been at work in the lives of the individuals in the group.
