FUMC Attends Arkansas Handbell Festival

Our FUMC handbell day started shortly before 9 a.m. on Saturday, Feb. 24, unloading 2 cars packed to the ceiling with five octaves each of bells and chimes along with everything else it takes for a choir to operate. This day was the 2024 Arkansas Handbell Festival, hosted by Highland Valley UMC in Little Rock. Members of our choirs attend this event each year, a full day of continuing education, fellowship, and terrific music making.

Throughout the day over three plenums and two divisional rehearsals, we, along with choirs from throughout our region, worked out the details of five repertoire items and presented them at the end of the day at an informal concert. This year, FUMC was very well represented at the Festival with 12 ringers both from our Bells of Grace and our Chancel Ringers.

Not only is this yearly gathering a chance to study music under a different conductor, it's a chance for our ringers to work together and to enjoy each other's company apart from our typical playing spaces.

Events like this teach us new ways to approach a musical art form we love and at the same time to engage in ways better to bring us all together, not only as a team but also as a choir of musicians in service to Church, the Liturgy,



and to the Most High -- and having tremendous fun while doing it.
