Her favorite memory at FUMC was going to Assembly in 2024 and getting to hang out with my friends.



Pierson Wekkin will be attending the University of Arkansas (Honors College) and plans on majoring in Sports Journalism with an emphasis of Sports Broadcasting.



Financial Update from Pastor Nathan

The Church is continuing to remain steady financially. Below you will see how the month of April concluded.

Also, we tackled the repair of the Trinity Building roof with totals more than \$200,000. We used a variety of reserve funds, memorial funds, and investments to pay for this. This wasn't originally on the docket for the year, but with the current tariff situation, the cost was going to rise \$30,000. We elected to move forward.

Regarding the Capital Campaign, we have now paid the loan down to \$200,000 with \$84,000 in reserve to make all the payments for the year. Any money received at this point, goes directly to the principal. It's amazing that in just 6 months, we've almost raised \$1,000,000 to pay down the loan! Thank you, church!
