



As you are aware, on Nov. 3 we announced our preliminary total for our "Unleashing our Potential" capital campaign. At the potluck, we announced we had pledged \$2.7 million! As of today, we have pledges of \$2.79 million! In fact, individuals have already begun paying their pledge. This week, we made a \$100,000+ payment to the principle on the loan! This is so wonderful!

Advent Series: Presence Matters

Presence matters. When we are present to others, it can change their outlook on a situation, it can give us strength to face a new day, or it can offer comfort in a difficult time. Presence is powerful.

This Advent, we are a kicking off a series of sermons around Jesus' birth and how his physical presence matters in our lives. Early in Christian history, followers of Jesus reflected a great deal on what would become known as the incarnation or Jesus becoming human. They came to see that God becoming flesh changed their lives. They began to see the benefits and blessing that came with Jesus Christ's presence in their life.

Throughout our Advent series, as we celebrate Emmanuel — God with us — we will be exploring the variety of ways Jesus' presence makes a difference in our lives. This series will be a great opportunity to explore the incarnation and why it matters. We hope you can join us and invite a friend or neighbor to join us as well!

'Isaiah's Voice': A Service of Advent Lessons and Carols



Since 1918, when the service of Christmas Lessons and Carols was first devised at King's College Chapel, Cambridge, communities of faith worldwide have maintained the tradition of gathering each year both at King's and at their local parish churches to hear the news of God's saving work in Word and song. This practice at Christmas had become so popular through the years, that a set of appointed lessons and prayers was made available specifically for use in the Advent season also, which foretell the coming of the Messiah, making ready his path to enter the world as one of us.


It is this order of Advent Lessons and Carols which we offer each year at First United Methodist Church, Conway, to the glory of God and for the benefit of our congregation as well as for that of the wider Conway community. Lessons and Carols here has been celebrated mid-December for many years, an integral part of the Advent observance for many people.


This year, we invite you to attend our Advent Lessons and Carols titled "Isaiah's Voice," on Dec. 15, the third Sunday of Advent, at 11 a.m. in the church Sanctuary.

This special service of singing, prayers, and lessons from Holy Scripture takes the place of the regularly scheduled 11 a.m. worship service. If you would like an opportunity to attend the service of Advent III, you may do so at either 8:30 a.m. in the Sanctuary or in the Good News Celebration at 9:05 a.m. in the Great Hall.

In addition to beloved carols and hymns of the season, there will be choral and instrumental works by Antonio Vivaldi, Charles Wood, Sally Beamish, Malcolm Boyle, David Johnson, William Mathias, Eleanor Daley, John Ferguson, and Denis Bédard. Musicians include the Chancel Ringers handbell choir, the treble choristers of the Joyful Sound and Aldersgate Choirs, the Chancel Choir of First United Methodist Church, Andrew Irvin, violin, and Betty Cohen and Jason Saugey, organists.

The Music Department of First United Methodist Church hopes that you take time to attend this annual offering of sacred music, Holy Scripture, and prayer as we anticipate with longing expectation to gaze into the manger of Bethlehem and see there the infant face of our salvation, the promised One of ages.




Thanks to Our Supporters for Refuge 2024


