Role of Summer Youth Ministry Intern at Conway FUMC:

To identify and/or cultivate a call to ministry for the participant through hands-on experiences in a multi-staff, large church setting.

We will do this by:

- Exposing the intern to excellent ministry work and leaders.
- Developing the intern's leadership and ministry gifts thru interaction with key staff and volunteer leaders.
- Giving the intern equal opportunities to lead and be led. Duties will be chosen to give the intern opportunities to manage the details of programming and also to practice ministry, participating in many of the programs while serving in the department.
- Helping the intern grow in knowledge, faith, and maturity within a ministry setting.

As a Youth Ministry Intern at Conway FUMC, you will:

- Be given specific job responsibilities and goals.
- Have scheduled meetings with your supervisor regarding the effectiveness of your work and to make sure the ministry is meeting your expectations.
- Attend an orientation session at the beginning of your internship.
- Provide a short reflection and evaluation paper at the conclusion of your service that summarizes your experiences and articulates the status of your ministry call.

Candidates:

- Preferred candidates will have completed their Junior year of college or be at least 21 years of age and have 2 years of work experience
- May be related to current staff members, but may not be supervised by that relative.
- Will not receive housing.
- Will work part-time (20 - 25 hrs./wk.) until mid-August
- Pay will be \$1100/month

Scope of Work

Dates: 06/01/26 – 08/08/26

Hours: TBD (20-25 hours per week)

Reports to: Director of Youth Ministries

Selected by: Director of Youth Ministries, in consultation with Senior and Associate Pastor

Weekly Involvement:

- Serve as a Christian example at all times – in the community, in personal life, and in conducting ministry with the youth.
- Develop, plan, and/or execute youth activities such as Bible Studies, retreats, weekly youth ministry meetings, activities, mission trips, and adult volunteer recruitment.
- Develop personal relationships with the youth.
- Assist the Youth Pastor during office/preparation time.
- Assist the Youth Pastor in leading weekly ministries, activities, trips, events, etc.
- Lead these programs when the Youth Pastor is unavailable.
- Prepare adequately for all events and activities. Preparation time may be on the church campus or off-campus, at times.
- Attend worship
- Be present and timely as needed to implement programs, events, and activities. Time off, excluding emergencies and sudden illness, should be scheduled in advance with the Youth Pastor. If lateness is anticipated, immediate contact with the Youth Pastor is imperative.
- Review meetings can be held to do a “check-up” on the Associate’s ministry work. Typically, these are monthly but may be scheduled as needed.
